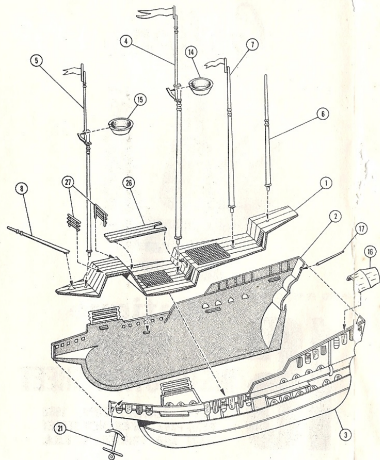
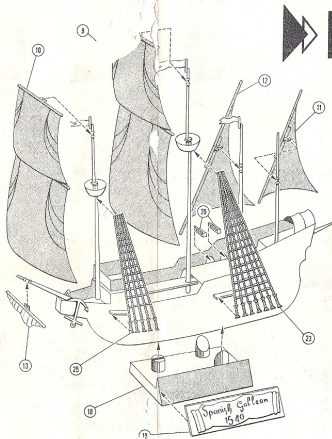

1. Cement Right (2) and Left (3) Hull Halves together.
2. Cement Deck (1) to Ribs on inside of Hull.
3. Cement Gangway (26) to Ribs on Deck as shown.
4. Cement 2 Railings (27) to Deck.
5. Cement 2 Anchors (21) over Railing at Bow.
6. Cement Bowsprit (8) to Hole in Deck.
7. Cement Outrigger (17) to Hole in Hull at Stern.
8. Cement Canopy Cover (16) to Railing at Stern.
9. Cement Fore Mast (5) to Hole in Fore Deck.
10. Cement Main Mast (4) to Main Deck.
11. Cement Mizzen Mast (7) to Half Deck.
12. Cement Bonaventure Mast (6) to Poop Deck.
13. Cement Fore Mast Cross Nest (13) around Fore Mast and to Arm extending from Fore Mast. Repeat procedure for Main Mast with Main Mast Cross Nest (14).

READ YOUR INSTRUCTION SHEET CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU START TO ASSEMBLE YOUR MODEL. USE ENAMEL OR PLASTIC PAINTS - YOU WILL FIND YOU CAN DO A BETTER JOB IF YOU PAINT MOST OF THE PARTS BEFORE ASSEMBLING. USE POLYSTYRENE CEMENT ONLY AND ALLOW PAINTED AND CEMENTED PARTS TO DRY THOROUGHLY BEFORE HANDLING. APPLY CEMENT CAREFULLY AND AVOID GETTING CEMENT ON HANDS SO AS NOT TO MAR PLASTIC SURFACES.



RIGGING: Use black sewing thread, following the illustration on box cover. The amount of care and time you spend on your rigging will pay off in a very attractive model.

14. Cement Name Plate (19) to Display Stand (18).
15. Cement Completed Display Stand to underside of Ship.
16. Cement Left Fore Mast Ratline (25) to Rib on outside of Hull at Bow and to underside of Fore Mast Cross Nest. Repeat for Right Side with Right Fore Mast Ratline.
17. Cement Left Main Mast Ratline (23) to Rib on outside of Hull at Stern and to underside of Main Mast Cross Nest. Repeat for Right Side with Right Main Mast Ratline.
18. Cement Sprit Sail (13) to Bowsprit.
19. Cement 4 Cannons (20) to each side of Half Deck with Muzzles protruding through Hole in Hull.
20. Cement Fore Sail (10) to Fore Mast.
21. Cement Main Sail (9) to Main Mast.
22. Cement Mizzen Sail (12) to Mizzen Mast.
23. Cement Bonaventure Sail (11) to Bonaventure Mast.
